

Step 5

Now you can add your property.

You can zoom in on the map to the location, using your mouse scroll or trackpad, OR type your address/ location in the *Search* bar.

Use your mouse to navigate around the map.

Once you have located your property, you can select individual parcels of land with a click of your mouse. At a minimum you must select a *Region* in the *Property location* section.

You can add as many parcels of land as needed.

Give your property a name and select all the enterprises/ commodities related to this property from the drop-down list. Make sure you include pasture, cropping and planting if relevant.

Answer the rainfall/irrigation question and select *Done*.

Note: Beef, sheep, goats, feedlot, grains, sugar, pork, cotton and poultry are currently available.


They will be closely followed by dairy, fisheries, horticulture, rice, aquaculture, wine, buffalo, deer and forestry.



Step 6

Now, it is time to add data to your business activities so that you can generate a GHG emissions report.

Get started by clicking on the *Business Activities* icon.



Step 7

Now you will be guided through adding your *business* — *activity data* for each enterprise/commodity you have selected. This includes adding energy, fuel and commodity consumption and allocating those across each enterprise.

Make sure you click *Done/Save* after entering data on each screen.
